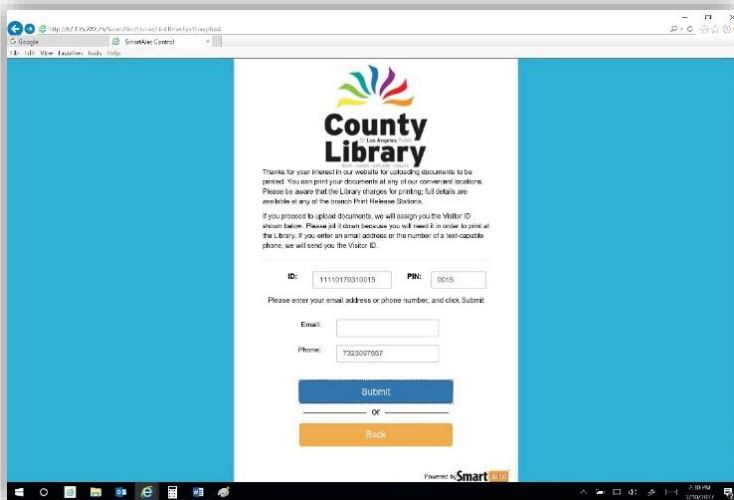

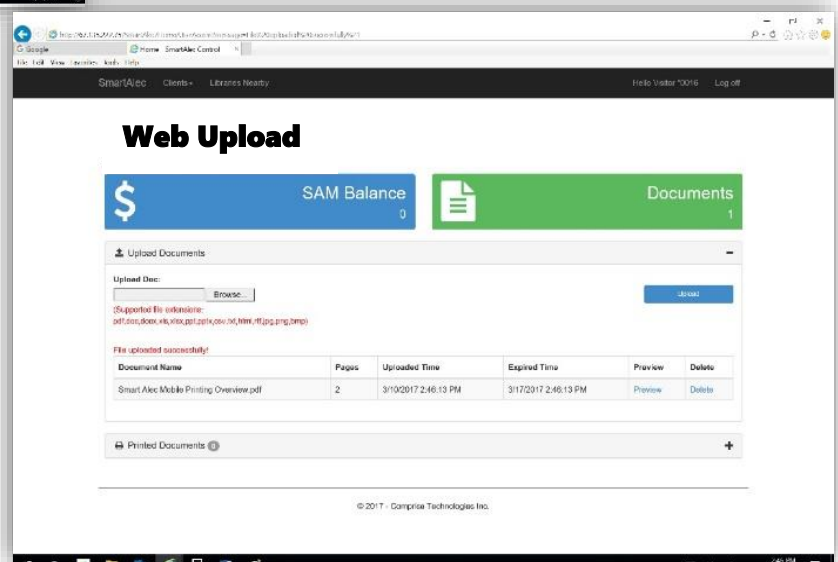

SmartALEC lets App users print directly to a Print Release Station from their Smartphone, tablet, or laptop... **no need to email print docs to oneself!**

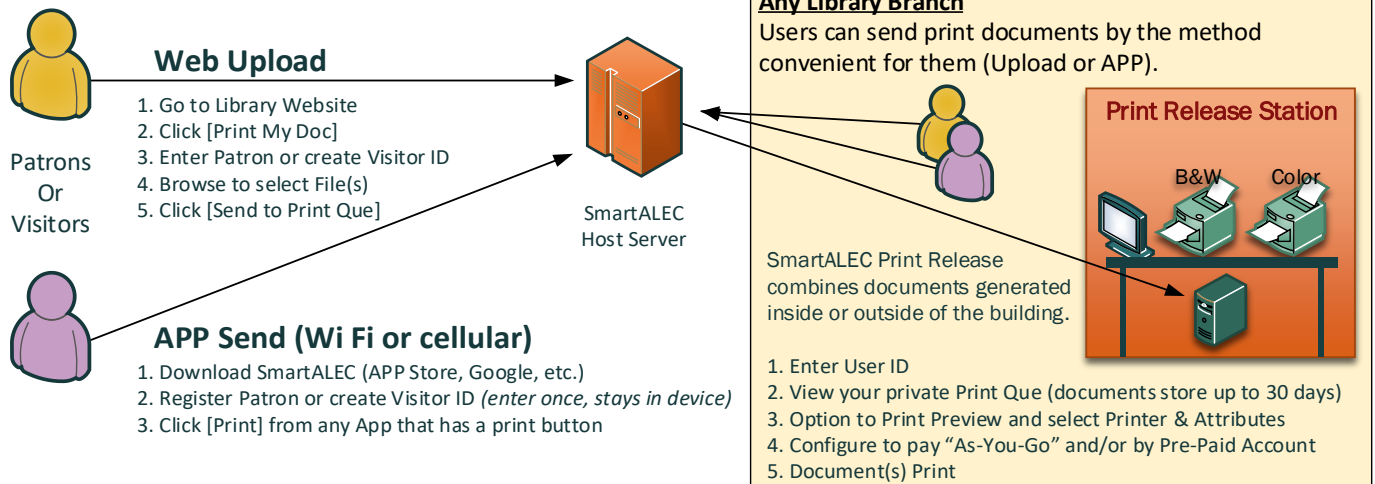
